Mike helped to re-launch NASA and was instrumental in launching the NASA magazine "Specialist Angler", and is famous for publishing his theories on "The Baiting Pyramid" in 1976. He has contributed to many angling books, famed for the invention of the "Latching Light" which is an integral part of all modern bite alarms. Mike is also well known for his talks and slide shows on the early days of Carp fishing and angling history. Although Mike is well known for his contribution to Carp fishing, only about half of the show is about Carp fishing. This show will be of equal interest to both Carp fishermen and general anglers alike. It is a fascinating insight into our sport.
